COLLINS Reuben Pte 266894, 1/6th Gloucestershire Regt killed in action on Friday 17/8/1917 in Belgium. Buried in Duhalow Advance Dressing Station (A.D.S) Cemetery, Belgium

POOLE James Charles Pte 17423 1st Grenadier Guards died 10/10/1917 age 24. Son of George and Martha of Barnsley. Commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium

SMITH Arthur Cpl 2108 Gloucestershire Regt died on Tuesday 24/9/1918. Son of William and Caroline of Barnsley. Buried in Etretat Churchyard extension, France II.G.6 Holder of the M.M & Bar

TEMPLE Ernest Charles Pte 19536, 3rd Grenadier Guards died between 14th & 17th/9/1916. Son of Charles and Elizabeth of Poulton Street, Poulton, Glos. Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme

WEAVER Reginald John Pte 19602, A Sqdn, 18th Queen Mary Own Hussars died 25/5/1918 age 21. Son of Leonard & Frances of Barnsley. Buried in St Albans Cemetery, Hertfordshire Mil.G.4

WEAVER Walter Thomas Pte 19329, 2/4th Gloucestershire Regt died on Monday 3/12/1917 age 34 Son of Thomas & Diana of Coln St Aldwyns, husband of Mary G. Commemorated on the Cambrai Memorial, Louveral, France
