**ASHWIN Harold D** Pte 9692, 2nd South Lancashire Regt, died 14/11/1914 age 21. Son of James and Keziah Ashwin of Watery Lane, Chipping Campden. Commemorated on the Menin Gate Memorial, Ypres, Belgium

**BEAVINGTON William** Pte 13721, B Coy, 8th Gloucestershire Regt, died 25/11/1914 age 17. Son of Richard and Mary E Beavington of Broad Campden, Glos. Buried at Tidworth Military Cemetery, Wilts

**NEVE Basil Hovenden** Chief Engine Room Artificer 2nd Class. 270424 HMS, Pathfinder died 5/9/1914. Son of Julias R and Isabelle of the Post Office and Drapers, High Street, Chipping Campden. Commerated on the Chatham Naval Memorial, Kent Born in 1875

**TRACEY Richard** Pte 9593, 3rd Worcestershire Regt, died 7/11/1914 age 29. Son of William and Ann Jane Tracey, nee Letts of Broad Campden, Glos Commemorated on the Menin Gate Memorial, Ypres, Belgium

**1915**

**ELLISHarry Gordon** Pte 13734, 5th Canadian Infantry (Saskatchewan Regt), died 24/5/1915 age 20. Son of Harry G and Martha of Chipping Campden. Commemorated on the Vimy Memorial, France and on a family grave in Chipping Campden Curchyard

**HATHAWAY Algernon** L/Cpl 10993, 7th Gloucestershire Regt killed in action at Festubert 7/8/1915 age 26. Son of George and Annie Hathaway of Grammer School Cottages, Chipping Campden. Commemorated on the Helles Memorial, Turkey

**HEDGES Charles** Pte 7404, 1st Gloucestershire Regt, killed in action, 8/10/1915. Commemorated on the Loos Memorial, France Additional information [1901 Census](#) Son of Frederick and Elizabeth A Hedges of 4 Aston Road, Campden

**HEDGES William Charles** Pte 17514, 10th Gloucestershire Regt, killed in action 25/9/1915 age 22. Son of Frederick and Elizabeth A Hedges of 4 Aston Road, Campden . Commemorated on the Loos Memorial, France

**HOWELL Frank Lewis** L/Cpl 9432, South Wales Borderers died 9/2/1915. Buried at St james churchyard, Chipping Campden. Additional information 1901 census Son of Eli Howell of Church Street, Chipping Campden, and the late Emily Tabitha Born 1888

**SMITH Thomas** Pte 17510, 10th Gloucestershire Regt, killed in action 25/9/1915.

Commemorated on the Loos Memorial, France. Native of Mickleton near Chipping Campden

**TRACEY Harry** Pte 9579, 1st Worcestershire Regt, died 13/3/1915. Commemorated on the Le Touret Memorial, France

## 1916

**BENNETT George Edwin** Pte 17656, 8th Gloucestershire Regt killed in action 23/7/1916. Buried at Caterpillar Valley Cemetery, Longueval, France. VII.B.33

**BINNS Raymond Louise** 2nd Lt, 8th Yorkshire Regt 10/7/1916 age 32. Son of Dr William Binns and Mrs Binns of The Cedars, East Bergholt, Suffolk. Educated at Stoneyhurst College, Lancs. Married 1913 to Maud, only daughter of Rev J and Mrs Cartman of Bondy Vicarage, Hull. Buried at Becourt Military Cemetery, Becordel-Becourt, France I.T.11

**BRAIN Charles Thomas** Pte 13234, 10th Gloucestershire Regt, killed in action, 23/10/1916 age 20. Son of John and Mary Katherine Brain, nee Ladbrook of Littleworth, Campden. And brother of Harold who also fell. Commemorated on the same memorial as his brother at Thiepval Somme, France

**BRAIN Harold William** Pte 23298, 10th Gloucestershire Regt killed in action 23/7/1916 age 18. Son of John and Mary Katherine Brain, nee Ladbrook and brother of Charles who also fell. Commemorated on the same memorial as his brother at Thiepval. This memorial have him listed as W.H.

**BRICKNELL Thomas** Pte 2435, 1/5th Gloucestershire Regt, killed in action 21/7/1916 age 32. Son of William Henry and Sarah Ann Bricknell of Broad Campden, Glos. Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme

**CALLAWAY Frederick James** Cpl 6560, 2nd Worcestershire Regt, died 5/8/1916 age 30. Son of James and Sarah Callaway of Worcester and husband of Frances Emily Callaway of Gainsborough Terrace, Campden, Glos. Buried at Knightbridge Cemetery, Mesnil-Martinsart, France. B.20

**DUNN John Gordon** Boy 2nd Class J/45953, HMS Impregnable died 16/2/1916 age 16. Son of Fred and Helen Dunn of The Chestnuts, Campden. Buried in St James churchyard Chipping Campden

**HAYDON Gilbert** Pte 2781, 1/5th Gloucestershire Regt, died 27/8/1916 age 27. Son of Robert Henry & Annie Haydon of Chipping Campden. Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme, France and on his parents memorial at Chipping Campden Churchyard

**JAMES Frank** Pte 7511, 1/23rd London Regt, died 16/9/1916 age 21. Son of John and Elizabeth Lucy James of 45 Stadium Street, Chelsea. Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme. Additional information, 1891 census residing at Lower High Street, Chipping Campden, 1901 living with his siblings at his grandparents home in Chipping Campden. Parents not with them Born Chipping Campden residing at Chelsea 1916

**OSBORNE Francis Raywood** Sgt 781, 10th Royal Fusiliers, died 4/5/1916 age 26. Son of Francis Bazley and Mary A Osborne of Malvern House, Blockley, Worcs. Born at Chipping Campden. Buried at Berles-Au-Bois Churchyard Extension, France E.6

**PAYNE Thomas Henry** L/Sgt 19563, 1st Grenadier Guards, died 10/9/1916 age 21. Son of Thomas and Sarah Payne of 7 Aston Road, Campden and brother of Frederick who fell in 1918 and served as alias James Buried at Guillemont Road Cemetery, Guillemont, France. VII.H.4

**PLESTED Tom** Pte 7974, 56th Coy, Machine Gun Corps (Inf) died 5/7/1916 age 19. Son of Jane and the late Ezra John Plested of Leasbourne, Chipping Campden. Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme

**SMITH Owen** Cpl 3628, 1/8th Post Office Rifles, London Regt died 7/10/1916 age 31. Son of Thomas William and Sarah Smith of the Square, Chipping Campden. Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme

**WILLIAMS Frank** Pte 4834, 1/5th Gloucestershire Regt, died of wounds 17/8/1916 age 29. Son of Joseph and Lucy Williams of Chipping Campden. Buried at Varennes Military Cemetery, France. I.A.21

### 1917

**BYRD William** Pte 24344, 10th Royal Berkshire Regt, transferred to as Pte 94864 159th Coy, Labour Corps died 1/11/1917 age 39. Son of Benjamin Henry and Alice Byrd of Broad Campden, Glos. Buried at Lijssenthoek Military Cemetery, Belgium. XXI.C.C.18A

**DYDE John** Pte 9668, 1st Royal Warwickshire Regt, died 4/10/1917. Commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium. Additional information [1901 census](#). Son of William and Maria Dyde of Lower High Street, Chipping Campden

**HANDS Leslie Hickman** Pte B/23339, 11th Royal Fusiliers died 4/3/1917 age 21. Son of Henry Joseph and Rosellen Hands nee Roberts of Cotswold. Keswick Road, Boscombe, Bournemouth. Native of Chipping Campden. Buried at St. Sever Cemetery Extension, Rouen, France. O.VII.E.1

**JAMES James** Pte 9194, 6th Oxford & Bucks Light Infantry died of wounds 2/12/1917 Buried at St Sever Cemetery Extension, Rouen, France Additional information, Courtesy of the [1901 census](#) Son of Jesse and Jane James nee Jones of Work House Bank known as Gainsborough Terrace, Sheep Street, Chipping Campden

**KEELEY George Charles** Pte 37851, B.Coy, 12th Gloucestershire Regt, killed in action 8/5/1917 age 31 Son of James and Mary Keeling of Lower High Street, Campden, brother of Thomas, who also fell and husband of Mabel Margaret Keeley nee Biggerstaff of 6 Sheep Street, Campden. Mobilized in 1914. Commemorated on the Arras memorial, France

**KEELEY Thomas Kilby** L/Sgt 238010, 2/4th Gloucestershire Regt killed in action 19/8/1917 age 29. Son of James and Mary Keeling of Lower High Street, Campden, brother of George, who also fell and husband of Agnes Ellen Keeley nee Sharpe of Church Cottage, Campden. Buried at New Irish Farm Cemetery, Belgium, XXI.E.6

**MERRIMAN Francis William** Pte 7335, Worcestershire Regt, died 12/4/1917 age 32 Son of Elizabeth Merriman nee Sandalls of Sheep Street, and husband of Julia Merriman nee Higgins of 8 Sheep Street, Chipping Campden Buried at St James churchyard, Chipping Campden

**ROBERTS Frederick Gordon** Cpl 106554, D Bty, 11th Bde, Royal Field Artillery died 24/9/1917 age 28. Son of Francis Edward and Annie Roberts. Native of Campden, Glos. Buried at Bleuet Farm Cemetery, Belgium. I.B.43

### 1918

**BAKER Henry Charles** Cpl 37356, 1/5th Gloucestershire Regt, killed in action in Italy 15/6/1918 age 35. Son of Joseph and Eliza Baker of Chipping Campden. From a bugler in the Volunteer Corps to his late rank in about 19 years. Buried at Magnaboschi British Cemetery, Italy. Plot 1, Row G, Grave 3

**BENNETT Ernest** Pte 26876 Gloucestershire Regt previously Pte 26222, C.Coy 2nd Loyay North Lancs Regt killed in action 29/7/1918 age 21. Son of Noah and Sarah Bennett of Park Road, Chipping Campden and brother of Richard who also fell. Buried at Raperie British Cemetery, Villemontoire, France IX.C.4

**BENNETT Richard** Unable to find the correct one. Additional information. [1901 census](#) Son of Noah and Sarah Bennett of Park Road, Chipping Campden and brother of Ernest who also fell.

**DYDE John Henry** Pte 14335, 2nd Coldstream Guards, died 27/8/1918 age 26. Son of Henry and Ada Annie Dyde nee Croft of Willicote Cottages, parish of Clifford Chambers, Glos. Buried at Croisilles British Cemetery France IV.A.31. Born at Quinton, Warwickshire, *Note, this memorial have him killed in 1917, CWG have him 1918*

**FISHER Edgar** Pte 9906, 1st Welsh Regt, transferred to as Pte 250191, 544th Home Service, Employment Coy, Labour Corps, died 27/6/1918 age 30. Son of Fanny Fisher of Broad Campden. Buried at St Margaret Churchyard, Bodelwyddan, Flintshire, now the County of Denbighshire

**GIBBINS Arthur Frederick** Private 241705, "C" Coy. 13th Bn. Gloucestershire Regt, died 09/04/1918 age 27. Son of Francis John and Clara Gibbins, of Mollington Mill, Banbury, Oxon. Born at Todenham, Moreton-in-Marsh, Glos. Buried at La Chapelette British and Indian Cemetery, Peronne France. *This memorial have him named as F A Gibbins*

**GRIFFIN William Henry** Pte 33607, 12th Gloucestershire Regt died 28/6/1918. Commemorated on the Ploegstreet Memorial, Belgium

**HARRIS Wilfred Henry** Pte 39379, 8th Gloucestershire Regt killed in action 4/4/1918. Son of John and Emily Harris of Mickleton near Chipping Campden. Buried at La Plus Douve Farm Cemetery, Belgium III.B.1

**HOWELL John Henry** CQMRS M2/099871 Royal Army Service Corps, died 2/12/1918 age 41. Buried at St James churchyard, Chipping Campden Son of Reuben and Eliza Howell, of Leysbourne, Campden; husband of Dora Howell, of Church Street Chipping Campden. Buried at St James Churchyard, Chipping Campden

**JAMES Harry** Pte 241706, D Coy, 2/5th Gloucestershire Regt reported missing 23/3/1918 and brother of George. Harry is mentioned on George's Head Stone and son of Enoch and Fanny Son of Enoch and Fanny James, of The Garden, Park Rd., Chipping Campden, Glos. Commemorated on the Pozieres Memorial, France

**JAMES George Enoch** Pte 15144 Gloucestershire Regt died 3/6/1918 age 24. in England. Brother of Harry who was reported missing presumed killed. Buried at St James churchyard, Chipping Campden

**JAMES Arthur William** Unable to find the correct one listed with the CWGC

**JEFFREY Alexander Charles** Saddler 840986, B Bty, 165th Bde, Royal Field Artillery died Regiment/Service: Royal Field Artillery Unit Text: "B" Bty. 165th Bde, died 20/10/1918 age 32. Son of William and Annie Jeffrey, of Chipping Campden, Glos. Buried at La Kreule Military Cemetery, Hazebrouck, France.

**KEEN William Cornock** Private SE/23168 4th Mobile Vet Section, Army Veterinary Corps died 12/4/1917 age 29. Son of Charles William and Clara Emily Keen, of Maul Farm, Haresfield, Glos. Commemorated on the Basra Memorial, Iraq.

**MERRIMAN Francis** Pte 7335, 2nd Worcestershire Regt died 12/4/1917 age 32. Husband of Julia Merriman of Sheep Street, Chipping campden. Buried at St James Churchyard, Chipping Campden. This memorial have him named as E.M.Merriman. Found a Francis native of this town

**NOEL Robert Thomas More** Captain (The Hon.) 6th Royal Fusiliers attached to 1st Bn Nigeria Regiment, W.A.F.F. died 2/2/1918 age 29. Son of Charles Francis, 3rd Earl of Gainsborough, and Countess of Gainsborough, of Exton Park, Oakham, England. Buried at Dar Es Salaam War Cemetery, Tanzania

**PAYNE Frederick R** Gunner 42513, 11th Siege Bty, Royal Garrison Artillery died 30/5/1918 age 25. Son of Thomas and Sarah Payne of 2 Deben Cottages, Park Road, Campden and brother of Thomas who fell in 1916. Buried at Crouy British Cemetery, Crouy-Sur-Somme, France. II.E.13

**TRINDER James** Pte 202782, 2nd Royal Scots Fusiliers died 22/3/1918. Buried at Roupy Road German Cem. Mem. Savy British Cemetery, France. Medal card of Trinder, James Pte 15143 Gloucestershire Regt and then Pte 202782, Royal Scots

**WALTON William Alfred** Private 27802, 1st Leinster Regiment died 23/10/1918 age 33. Son of Alfred and Elizabeth Walton; husband of Elsie May Walton, of High Street, Chipping Campden. Buried at the Gaza War Cemetery, Iraq

**WILLIAMS William Robert** Unable to find the correct one listed with the CWGC

**BRUCE Charles John** Pte 2240, Gloucestershire Regt, died 3/8/1919 Son of of Mr. and Mrs. C. Bruce, of Berrington, Chipping Campden, and brother of *Pte 24004 Oscar, Gloucestershire Regt who fell 17/1/1918* . Charles is buried at St James Churchyard, Chipping Campden.

**KEEN Arthur Henry Fred** Officer's Steward 1st Class 363448, H.M.S. "Impregnable" Royal Navy died 27/12/1919 age 34. Son of Henry and Sarah Sadler Keen, of Park Road, Campden. Buried at St James Churchyard, Chipping Campden

**WHATCOTT Joseph George** Gunner 225766, Royal Field Artillery died 17/2/1919, 23 Buried at St James churchyard, Chipping Campden Additional information 1901 census. Son of George and Sarah A Whatcott of Campden Ashes, Chipping Campden
