BENNETT Repton L/cp 13114239, 141 Pioneer Corps died 28/6/1943 aged 28. Son of Joseph & Elizabeth Ann Maria of Chipping Campden. Buried at Medjez-El-Bab, War Cemetery, Tunisia 13.D.4

BRUNDLE Victor Charles Rifleman 7017973, 7th Bn, 1st The London Rifle Brigade died 29/9/1944 aged 28. Son of Richard Charles & Annie of Campden, Glos and husband of Alice of Campden. Buried at Florence War Cemetery, Italy. IV.B.18

CROSS Fred Private 5249458, 1st Worcestershire Regiment died 16/8/1944 aged 33. Son of Thomas and Ellen Cross; husband of Alice Mary Cross, of Broadway, Worcestershire. Buried at Banneville-La-Campagne War Cemetery, France. II.D.5

FREEMAN Gordon Trooper 4798980, Life Guards, died 24/9/1941 aged 31. Son of Charles & Annie, husband of Mary F of Torquay, Devon. Buried at Tehran War cemetery, Iran. I.C.4

GRIGGS John Ceolfrid Lt, 255808, 2nd North Staffs Regt, died 30/5/1944. Son of Frederick Landseer Maurice & Nina Mary of Boar's Hill, Oxford. Buried at Beach Head War Cemetery, Italy. XVI.H.7

HADLEY Joseph Eliot Captain 34141, Royal Warwickshire Regt, died 6/6/1944 aged 44. Son of Soloman & Martha and husband of Edith Annie Woodall Hadley of Campden. Buried at Sangro River War Cemetery, Italy. V.E.41

HARRIS Cyril Victor Bombardier 1472761, 112 H.A.A. Regt, Royal Artillery, died 24/3/1945 aged 36. Son of William & Kate Kirby Harris of Campden, husband of Ann Elizabeth Jane Harris of Campden. Buried at Groesbeek Canadian War Cemetery, Holland VI.B.13

JAMES Bryan Only one Bryan listed with the CWGC and that is a young boy aged three who died 19/11/1940 Son of John James, and of Ruth James. Died at 26 Knighton Road. Buried in Leicester Cemetery This Bryan James may have a different 1st name

KEELEY Donald Sgt 1381057, 115 Sqdn Royal Air Force. Commemorated on the Runnymede Memorial

KEELEY Roy Acting Sub Lt, (A) HMS Bambara, Royal Navy died 29/7/1945 aged 20. Son of Mr & Mrs L J Keely of Campden. Commemorated on the Lee-on-Solent, Memorial

KEELY Alec Victor Aircraftman 1st Class 953264, 52 Sqdn Royal Air Force, died 01/12/1942. Son of Ernest and Ida Eleanor Keeley, of Campden, Buried at Mosul War Cemetery, Iraq, 2. D. 4.

PARSONS Robert Gerald Victor Leading Aircraftman 923128, 212 Sqdn, Royal Air Force, died 24/8/1943, aged 28. Son of Mr & Mrs John Parsons, husband of Ethel Mary of Campden. Buried at Delhi War Cemetery, India. 2.D.15

PEMBERTON David Alwyn Sqdn Leader Pilot, 33036, 1 Sqdn, Foyal Air Force, 3/11/1940 aged 28. Son of Guy [F.R.I.B.A]and Emily Murial of Broadway, Worcestershire. Buried at St Eadburgh New Churchyard, Broadway

POWELL Norman Henry Sgt 1396063, 295 Sqdn, Royal Air Force, died 28/4/1944 age 26. Son of Harry and Catherine Mabel Powell of Westington. Buried at St James Churchyard, Chipping Norton

TEMPLE William Unable to find the correct one listed with the CWGC

TROLLOPE Ronald William Bombardier 1468503, 98, H.A.A. Regt, Royal Artillery, died 11/4/1943 age 28. Husband of E F Trollope of Swindon, Wilts. Buried in Whitworth Road, Cemetery, Swindon, Wilts Sec F Grave 456
