**The Great War**

**ABRA George** Pte 4073, 2/4th Gloucestershire Regt transferred to Labour Corps as Pte 346596. Died 8/11/1918 age 19. Son of George and Susanna of Bristol Road, Frampton Cotterell. Buried at Arnos Vale Cemetery, Bristol. Screen Wall 3.722

**BRACY Frederick** Not listed with the CWGC

**DREW Francis Lionel** Pte 266939 previously 5288, 1/6th Gloucestershire Regt killed in action on Monday, 5/2/1917. Son of Alfred Edward H and Sarah A, nee Hathway of Frampton Common, Frampton Cotterell Buried in Heath Cemetery, Harbonniers, France. VIII.H.4

**EACOTT Ronald James** L/Cpl 15059 9th Leicestershire Regt, died 1/10/1917 age 22. Son of James George and Georgina nee Foote Nephew of Emma Eleanor Roach, of East View, Bagstone, Wickwar, Glos. Commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium and also on a family memorial in the churchyard St Peter's the parish church.

**EBSWORTH Percy** Pte 16996, 8th Somerset Light Infantry, died, 23/4/1917. Buried at Browns' Copse Cemetery, Roeux, France, I.E.39

**GIFFORD George** Pte 33926, 1st Wiltshire Regt, died, 4/8/1917 age 22. Son of George and Elizabeth nee Pullin of Harris Barton, Frampton Cotterell. Commemorated on the Menin Gate, Memorial, Ypres, Belgium

**HALE Henry** *It may be this person* **Henry Thomas HALES.** Pte 202108, 2/5th Gloucestershire Regt, killed in action on Monday 27/8/1918 age 41. Son of the late Henry Thomas and Hesther nee Britton and husband of Elizabeth Anne Hales of 7.Sentry Avenue, Lawrence Hill, Bristol. Commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium [ *No listing for a Henry Hale with the CWGC* ]

**HOBBS Albert** Pte 18894 1/5th Gloucestershire Regt, killed in action on Thursday 16/8/1917. Son of Thomas and Clara Hobbs of Wadleys End, Winterbourne, Glos. Buried at Poelcapelle British Cemetery, Belgium.XIV.F.13

**HOLDER Leonard George** Pte 145 44, 7th Somerset Light Infantry, died, 13/6/1916 age 20. Son Edwin and Elizabeth, Frampton Common, Frampton. Buried at Vlamertinghe Military Cemetery, Belgium. III.B.1

**MILLETT Harold** Pte 21340, 9th Army Cyclist Corps, died 19/10/1918 age 22. Son of Albert and Elizabeth of 4, School Road, Frampton Cotterell. Buried at Highland Cemetery, Le Cateau, France. XII.A.6

**REVELEY Charles** Pte 10317 2nd South Wales Borderers, died 26/4/1915. Grandson of Mary Ann Hollister and son of Alice [1901, widowed] all at Crossley Cottage, Winterbourne, Glos. Commemorated on the Helles Memorial, Turkey

**ROBBINS William** Guardsman 8803, 1<sup>st</sup> Grenadier Guards, died, 16/1/1919 age 35. Husband of Ada Robbins nee Type of &. Warminster Road, St Werburgs, Bristol. Buried at Brunswick Square, Unitarian Burying Ground, Bristol The National Archives , Medal Roll have him as Pte 8803, Grenadier Guards. (1901 census he was stationed at Victoria Barracks, Windsor a Private with the Grenadier Guards. Born at Bristol)

**ROGERS Charles** Son of Charles and Annie Rogers of Frampton Common, Frampton Cotterell Born 1894 in Frampton Cotterell [Unable to find the correct Charles]

**SHORT Eden** Pte 14147, 19th Queen Alexandra's Own Royal Hussars, died, 8/10/1918. Son of John Davis Short and Jane of Frampton Common, Frampton Cotterell Buried at Prospect Hill Cemetery, Gouy, France III.D.2

**STIFF Cecil Garnett** Pte 460174, 44th Canadian Infantry, New Brunswick Regt, died 6/5/1917 age 31. Son of William Edmund and Cecilia Rebecca Stiff, nee Sampson of Frampton Cotterell and brother of Horace Roy who also fell. Buried at SS Peter and Paul Churchyard, Frampton Cotterell

**STIFF Horace Roy** Sgt 11195, 61st Bty, Royal Field Artillery Died of rheumatic fever 18th December 1917. Age 23. Son of William Edmund and Cecilia Rebecca Stiff. Born at Frampton Cotterell. Brother of Cecil Garnet who also fell Buried at SS Peter and Paul Churchyard, Frampton Cotterell

**STONE Henry Joseph** Sgt 14850, 7th Bedfordshire Regt died 3/5/1817 age 27. Son of Albert James and Georgina of Church Road, Frampton Cotterell. Commemorated on the Arras Memorial, France

**STONE Reginald** Son of Albert James and Georgina of Brookridge Hill, Frampton Cottrell. Unable to find his Regiment

**STRUGNELL Christopher George** Pte 67885, 7th Royal Fusiliers, died, 30/10/1917. Son of George Edward and Eleanor Gilmore nee Samuel . His occupation in 1901 was a Pupil Teacher in a National School. Commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium

**WARWICK Victor Albert Ernest** L/Cpl 2400, 3, Northumberland Fusiliers, died 5/5/1916 age 33. Son of William and Rose Warwick, nee Bray of Bromley, Kent and husband of Mabel nee Parker who were married about March 1916. of Frampton Cotterell. Enlisted 1908 and served in India and wounded in France. Buried at Bishopwearmouth, Cemetery, Sunderland. 2.AE.1404

**WHEELER Herbert George** Pte 10482 5th, Royal Berkshire Regt, died, 19/7/1917 age 21. Son of the late Mr and Mrs G Wheeler. (*Additional information Son of George and Pamela nee Duck of 52, Salisbury Road, Gloucester City 1901 census Pamela was widowed*) Commemorated on the Arras Memorial, France

**BRASSINGTON Arnold Ernest James** Ordinary seaman D/SSX 30629. HMS Wildfire, Royal Navy, died 15/9/1939 age 17. Son of Ernest James and Mabel Blakey of Blackpool, Lancs. Buried in Woodlands Cemetery, Gillingham Naval Reservation Kent, Grave 1218

**RICHARDSON Ronald George** Driver T/221470, Royal Army Service Corps died, 28/8/1944 age 32. Husband of K M Richardson of Filton. Buried at SS Peter and Paul Churchyard, Frampton Cotterell
