**ARNEY** Frank Stanley 2nd Lt ,1st Medium Trench Mortar Bty, Royal Field Artillery died 18/4/1918 age 21. Son of James Hicks & Annie Adela Hardwick Arney, 23 bayswater Avenue, Redland, Bristol. Buried in Doiran Military Cemetery, Greece. I.F.5

**ALEXANDER** Charles L/Cpl 235661 died 12/11/1917. Commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial, Israel

**AITKEN** Sidney William J CWGC not listed. Born in 1893

**ANSTEY** George Benjamin Trooper 235732 died 16/12/1917. Commemorated on the Bassra Memorial, Iraq

**APPERLEY** Albert James Trooper 235167 died 30/12/1917. Commemorated on the Chatby Memorial, Egypt

**BREWER** Edmund Sgt 1472 Gloucestershire Hussars and 2nd Lt 3/1st Glamorgan Yeomanry South wales Berderers attached to the 12th Bn, died 12/1/1918. Buried in Achiet-Le-Grand Cemetery Extension, France II.C.8

**BROWNING** Edwin Ormonde On Medal Roll, Pte 2087 Gloucestershire Hussars On the CWGC, 2nd Lt 11th attached 7th Gloucestershire Regt. Commemorated on the Basra Memorial, Iraq

*Additional information.* Son of Edwin, (Mechanical Engineer and Elizabeth A of 2 Manson Terrace, St Margarets Road, Cheltenham, Glos Born in 1892

**BAYLEY** Reginald John 2nd Lt, 13th Royal Fusiliers, was Pte R/37209 Officer Training Corps. Died 29/4/1917 age 19. Son of John William & Isabella Annie, Grey Friars House, Gloucester. Commemorated on the Arras Memorial France

**BENGOUGH** John Crosbie, Captain, Berkeley Troop, B.Sqdn att to Dorset Yeomanry (Queens Own) died 26/2/1916 age 27. Born at Wotton Under Edge, eldest son of John A G & Rosa M of Tocknells House, Painswick, A.D.C to General Peyton. Buried in Chatby Military & War Cemetery, Alexandria, Egypt. G.35

**BRAIN** John Edward Bennett, Cpl, died 4/12/1916 age 22. Son of Mr C J & Mrs F.I.R. Brain, Rock House, Brierley, Ruardean. Buried in North Gate War Cemetery, Baghdad, Iraq. Angora Memorial

**BRYAN** Arthur Edwin Cpl 110828, 16th Sqdn, Machine Gun Corps (Cavalry) died 19/11/1917 age 24. Son of Edwin & Jane, Brook House, Doynnton, Bristol. Native of Marshfield, Gloucestershire. Buried in Hadra war Memorial Cemetery, Alexandria, Egypt. D.22. Holder of the Gold Medal (Serbia)

**BARNETT** Francis Edwin L/Cpl 235297 died 20/4/1917 age 25. Son of Edwin & Charlotte E of Hanberbury, Lydbrook, Ross, Herefordshire. Buried in the Gaza war Cemetery, Israel XX.D.11

**BARTON** Wilfred L/Cpl 1887, died 21/8/1915 age 32. Son of Edward & Jane of The Knowle, Ampney Crucis, Cirencester. Buried in Green Hill Cemetery, Turkey, II.C.3

**BOULTON** William John L/Cpl 2230 B Sqdn died 9/1/1917 age 26. Son of John & Susan of Sheepscombe Glos. Buried in Kantara War Memorial Cemetery Egypt. F.20

**BALL** Francis Henry, Shoeing Smith 1800, died 21/8/1915 age 23. Son of Job & M.A of Northwick, Pilning, Glos Buried in Green Hill Cemetery, Turkey. Spec Mem A.12

**BAKER** William, M.M. Trooper 2486 Gloucestershire Yeomanry. Pte 235365 Corps of Hussars. Died 1/12/1917. Commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial, Israel

**BALDWIN** Percival Charles, Trooper 4218, Gloucestershire Yeomanry, Pte 39768 1/5th Gloucestershire Regt died 18/10/1918 age 20 son of W J & Hannah, 65 Vicarage Road, Whitehall, Bristol. Buried in Pommereuil British Cemetery, France. B.34

**BALL** Clarence Percival Pte 37492 1/5th Gloucestershire Regt died 19/10/1918 age 20. Son of Alfred & Kate, 4 Beufort Place, Staple Hill, Bristol. Commemorated on the Vis-En-Artois Memorial France

Note shown on the CWGC site as being in the Gloucestershire Hussars. Medal Roll also shows him as Pte 37492 Gloucestershire Regt and then Pte 474313, Labour Corps

**BEREKELEY** Arthur Lucas, Pte 40215 4th Worcestershire Regt died 14/4/1918 age 27. Son of I H & Sarah, Broad Street, Newent, Glos. Previously served as Pte 2800 Gloucestershire Yeomanry. Commemorated on the Ploegsteert Memorial, Belgium

**BISS** Reginald Frederick Trooper 1963 died 28/8/1915 age 20. Son of Frederick & Ellen, Home farm, Knole Park, Almondsbury. Glos. Buried in Green Hill Cemetery, Turkey, II.G.5

**BLAKE** Francis H Pte 235285, 12th Gloucestershire Regt died 25/8/1918 age 34. Husband of Jessie A, 161 Whiteway Road, Kingswood, Bristol. Previously served at Trooper 236121 Gloucestershire Yeomanry. Commemorated on the Vis-en-rtois Memorial, France

**BLANCHE** Alvan Digby (CWGC as an **Alvan Digby Blanch**, listed) Pte 4026 2nd Worcestershire Regt died 5/11/1916. Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme. Medal Roll shows him also as Pte 3633 Royal Garrison Artillery

*Additional information.* Son of Alvan J, Farmer, and Hannah M of Latteridge, Iron Acton, Glos. Born in 1892

**BROUARD** Ernest James (Laddie) Trooper 2465 died 9/1/1917 age 24. Son of Adolphus & Matilda Elizabeth, Millbrook, Kings Road, Gurnsey also served in the Dardanelles. Buried in Kantara war Memorial Cemetery, Egypt, F. 94

**BURTON** William Arthur Austin Trooper 276065, died 5/5/1918 age 21. Son of Arthur Austin & L E Burton of 57 Central Avenue, Worksop, Notts. Buried in Damascus Commonwealth War Cemetery Syria. E.52

**BUTLER** Francis Walter Pte 27657, D Coy 14th Royal Warwickshire Regt, died 27/9/1918, age 29. Son of George & Martha of Oriel House, Bath Road, Cheltenham brother of George Henry. Buried in Neuville-Bourjonval British Cemetery, France C.35. Previously served as Trooper 2474, Gloucestershire Yeomanry

**BUTLER** George Henry Pte 203477, 8th Gloucestershire Regt died 23/10/1918. husband of G Butler, Oriel House, Bath Road Cheltenham and son of George and Martha, same abode and brother of Francis Walter. Buried in St Aubert British Cemetery, France, V.A.19 Previously served at Pte 8221, Gloucestershire Regt

**CLIFFORD** Henry Francis Major, B. Sqdn died 9/1/1917 age 45. Son of Henry James & Annie of Frampton Court, Glos and husband of Hilda same abode. Served in the South African Campaign. Buried in Kantara war Memorial Cemetery Egypt. C.40

**CRADDOCK** Herbert C (*Not found on the CWGC*) On the Medal Rolls this soldier is listed. Pte 2302 Herbert S Craddock of the Queen's Own Oxfordshire Hussars, same number for the Gloucestershire Yeomanry and Pte 285458 Corps of Hussars

**CHURCHILL** Lionel George Cpl 2215 died 24/8/1915 age 32. Son of Mark & Elizabeth, Kirby House, Station Road, Semley, Wilts. Served in the South African War and five years in the Cape Mounted Rifles. Commemorated on the Helles Memorial, Turkey (Only this one listed)

**CROOK** William H Cpl 2545 died 13/12/1915. Buried in Chatby Military & war Memorial Cemetery, Alexandria, Egypt. G.2

**COATES** John L/Cpl 17496, died 9/5/1918 age 23. Son of Henry & Ada, Priory Cottage, Newton, Castleford, Yorks, his brother William also fell. Native of Ledsham, South Milford. Buried in Jerusalem War Cemetery, Israel. O.65

**CARTER** Carey Edward M Trooper 2004, died 21/8/1915 age 20. Son of Louis E & A M Carter, Woolstrop Farm, Quedgley. Buried in Green Hill Cemetery, Turkey, II.C.19

**CLARKE** A Also searched under Clark, no listing either on the Medal Roll & CWGC for the Gloucestershire Hussars. There are a few for the Gloucestershire Regt

**CLARK** Reginald C Only one listed on the CWGC site. Pte 9759, 1st Gloucestershire Regt, died 29/10/1914. Commemorated on the Menin Gate Memorial, Ypres, Belgium

**COOK** Alfred Dennis Pte 203481 2/5th Gloucestershire Regt died 21/3/1918 age 36. husband of Amy Florence, nee Langfield , 29 Coxwell Street, Cirencester. Commemorated on the Pozieres Memorial, Somme

*Found on the Medal Roll but not listed on the CWGC. Pte 3002, Gloucestershire Yeomanry and as Pte 110538. Machine Gun Corps*

**COX** Bence Trooper 235137 B Sqdn, died 1/12/1917 age 21. Son of Frank & Kate, Wellstead Farm, Yate, Glos. Buried in the Ramleh War cemetery, Israel R.13

**COX** Frederick Charles Only found this person who died. L/Cpl 1896, 2<sup>nd</sup> Gloucestershire Regt died 13/5/1915. Son of Mr O H Cox of 17 Marlborough Road, Gloucester. Commemorated on the Menin Gate Memorial, Ypres, Belgium.

Listed on the Medal Roll are Frederick Charles Pte 265225, 6<sup>th</sup> Glosters and as Pte 2070TF, 2/6 Glosters. They are not listed with the CWGC

**COXWELL-ROGERS** Richard Hugh Trooper 2234 died 21/8/1915 age 31. only son of Godfrey Coxwell Rogers & Aileen Coxwell Rogers, Kilcrone, Cloyne County Cork. Buried in Green Hill Cemetery, Turkey

**CROCKER** Thomas Trooper 2585 died 21/8/1915 age 36. Husband of Annie, Hillside Green, Newbury. Buried in Green Hill Cemetery, Turkey, II.C.4

**CROCKETT** William Edwin Trooper 235835 died 19/4/1917 age 26. Son of James & Kate Bertha, Hill View, Hotspur Road Woodburn, Bucks. Commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial, Israel

**CROUCH** Ernest William Pte 41768 7th Leicestershire Regt died 9/8/1918 age 34. Husband of Elizabeth, 23 sidney Street, Glos. Buried in Englebelmer Communal Cemetery Extension, Somme. C.3 (CWGC no listing for the R.G.H.Y)

**DRAKE** Percy Herbert 2nd Lt, 11th Gloucestershire Regt died 13/10/1916 age 26. Son of Joseph & Helena, Coombe Bissett, Salisbury. Buried in Longsdale Cemetery, Authuille Somme VIII.A.4

**DAWE** Reginald Mark L/Cpl. Pte 35668 5th Yorkshire Regt, 76 Milbourne Street, Tredworth, Glos. Buried in St. Erne Communal Cemetery Extension, France. A.18  
Previously served as Pte 42293 Gloucestershire Regt. No listing on the CWGC for R.G.H.Y and L/Cpl *Additional information* Born in 1890, a native of Gloucestershire

**DANIELL** Arthur Pte 267585 1/6th Gloucestershire Regt, died 9/10/1917. Commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium. No listing on the CWGC for R.G.H.Y

**DAVIS** Albert Edward, Trooper 2933 died 23/4/1916. Commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium

**DEAN** Lionel Charles Trooper 1975 died 9/9/1915. Commemorated on the Helles Memorial, Turkey

**DEE** Fred Pte 40230 C Coy 2nd Worcestershire regt died 8/11/1916 age 20. Son of William Henry & Mary Ann, 7 Church Street, Tewkesbury. Buried in St Sever Cemetery Extension Rouen, France O.I.H.10 Previously served as Trooper (Pte) 3618, Gloucestershire Yeomanry

**DOWNHAM** Percy James Trooper 2985, died 23/4/1916 age 27 only son of William & Annie Maria, Watermead, Brockworth, Glos. Commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial, Israel

**DUDLEY F** CWGC & Medal Roll have no listing for a Dudley F in the R.G.H.Y  
The only Dudley found on the Medal Roll for the Yeomanry is Pte 3155 Cyril B of the Gloucestershire Yeomanry and as Pte 40228 of the Worcestershire Regt

**DYER** Dudley Henry Alan Pte 260309, 12 Gloucestershire Regt died 4/10/1917 age 22. Son of Mr & Mrs Harry Dyer, Church house, Oxenhall, Glos Commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium (CWGC no listing for R.G.H.Y.)

**ELCHO** Hugo Francis Charteris Capt, died 23/4/1916. Commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial, Israel. True name **CHARTERIS**, Lord Hugo Francis Charteris, Capt, s/o 11th earl & Countess of Wemys of Gosford, Aberlady, Edinburgh, husband of Lady Elcho (nee Lady Catherine Manners) now Lady Violet Benson) 32 Montagu Square, London, West. His brother Ivo Alan Charles also fell

**ESSEX** Robert Charles Lt, B Bty, 162nd Bde, Royal Field Artillery died 14/5/1918, age 21. Son of Robert Charles & Mildred Eva of Gloucester City husband of Violet Edith Amy "Martehoe" Central Road, Gloucester. Buried in Esquelbecq Military Cemetery, France. I.D.16

**EVERARD** Clement Charles, Lt, Manchester & Derbyshire Regt died 7/9/1916. Son of Mr & Mrs Edward Everard, husband of Daisy Marion of Brunswick House, 4 Cotham Park, Bristol. Buried in Bouzincourt Communal Cemetery Extension, Somme I.F.10. Formerly Staff Sgt Major 726 R.G.H.Y

**ELLIS** Herbert Pearce, M.C., 2nd Lt, B, Sqdn, died 1/12/1917 age 31. Son of Henry Arthur & Caroline Anne, of Highnam, Glos. Commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial

**EDWARDS** John Vaughan Cpl 235066, died 12/11/1917 age 28. Son of Walter & Sarah Jane, of Middle Yaer, Bwlch, Breconshire. Commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial

**EMERSON** Wilfred Charles Cpl 2189, died 23/4/1916 age 32. Son of John & A of Fairwater Farm, Michaelston-y-Vedw, Cardiff. Commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial

**ELLIS** E G, M.C., Trooper, (CWGC have this person listed) L/Sgt G/1821 Ernest Gordon, C Coy 7<sup>th</sup> The Queens's Royal West Surrey Regt died 8/11/1916 age 28. Son of Walter & Fanny of the White Hart, Woking Surrey and late of 5 Walton Road, Woking. The holder of the Military Medal. Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme  
*No E G Ellis found for the RGH and the holder of the MM on the CWGC*

**EMBRY** Albert Victor Trooper 32297 died 5/1/1919 age 21. Son of Edward & Kate 126 Brunswick Street, Leicester. Buried in Beirut War Cemetery. Lebanese Republic 253

**EVANS W** Unable to find him

**FURZER** Walter James L/Cpl 1978, D Sqdn, died 21/1/1917 age 24. Son of Herbert & Mary, 39 Victoria Avenue, Maindee, Newport, Mon. Buried in Kantara War Memorial Cemetery, Egypt. D.25

**FORD** Percy Daniel Trooper 3039, died 26/11/1915 age 27. Son of George & Sarah of Rudford, husband of Bertha, the Police Station, Pittville, Cheltenham. Buried in St Mary Churchyard, Rudford, Glos

**FOWLER** Osman Karl Trooper 1908, died 21/8/1915. Buried in Green Hill, Turkey, II.C.20  
*Additional information* Son of William (Farmer & Manure Agent) and Agnes of Corse End Farm, Hartpury, Glos and is one of seven children

**FREEMAN** A CWGC not listed as being in the RGHY, Found him on the Medal Roll. Albert, Pte 2573, Gloucestershire Yeomanry

**FREEMAN** Charles Stow Trooper 2345, died 28/8/1915, age 20. Son of George & caroline Augusta, of Sherborne, Northleach, Glos. Commemorated on the Helles Memorial, Turkey

**FROST** Edward Pte 267569 2/5th Gloucestershire Regt, buried in Brandhoek New Military Cemetery, No3 Belgium, I.E.15. Previously Pte TF/2376 Gloucestershire Regt. CWGC not listed as being in the R G H Y

**FRY** Reginald Frank Pte 39696, 12th Gloucestershire Regt died 13/12/1917, age 19. Son of Edward & Elizabeth, 26 Victoria Road, Redfield, Bristol. Buried in les Baraques Military Cemetery, Sangatte, France. II.B.10A CWGC no listing as being in the RGHY

**GODWIN** William Bernard 2nd Lt, 9th attached to 12th Middlesex Regt died 17/2/1917. Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme Medal Roll have him as Cpl 2202 Gloucestershire Hussars

**GETHING** Hugh Bagnall 2nd Lt, D.Sqdn died 21/8/1915 age 31. Son of James Edward & Maria Llewellyn, of Hinton House, Brackley, Northants. Commemorated at Green Hill Cemetery, Turkey, Special Memorial, C.1

**GASSER** Frederick John (*On memorial, rank as Cpl*). L/Cpl,27641 Royal Warwickshire Regt died 29/9/1918 age 25. Son of Mr & Mrs Thomas Gasser. Of Lockside, Sharpness, Glos. Commemorated on the Vis-en-Artois Memorial France. No listing either on the CWGC and Medal Roll as being in the RGHY

**GREEN** Arthur Reginald Cpl 235850, died 13/10/1918 age 30. Son of Arthur Charles & Rowena, of 1 Raymond Terrace, Cheltenham and is buried in Cheltenham Cemetery, Glos. AI.2129

**GUNNING** Clifford (Chap) L/Cpl P/15174 Military Police Corps formerly Royal Gloucestershire Hussars. Died 10/6/1920, age 27. Son of Sudney Herbert & Eleanor Maria, of Easton Toun, Sherston, Malmesbury. Buried in the Holy Cross Churchyard, Sherston Magna, Wilts. Grave 127

**GARRETT** John Pte 50370 1st Garrison Bn, Devonshire Regt, died 11/5/1917 age 39. Husband of Lottie E M, 19 Sydenham Road, Knowle, Bristol. Buried in Hadra War Memorial Cemetery,

Alexandria, Egypt D.125. Medal Roll also have him as previously being Pte 2142, Gloucestershire Yeomanry

**GILL** Frank W Trooper 3020 died 29/9/1916. Commemorated on the Angora memorial 72, North Gate war Cemetery, Baghdad, Iraq

**GORDON** David Trooper 331433, died 5/11/1917 age 23. Son of John & Ann Mackenzie Gordon, of Kirkmichael, Perthshire. Buried in Beersheba war Cemetery, Israel. A.4

**GREEN** William Trooper, CWGC have him listed as William Edward, 2154, died 23/4/1916 age 39. Husband of Mary Helena of Lodge Road, Apperley, Tewkesbury, Glos and is commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial, Israel. *Additional information* He was the son of Richard & Mary from Didbrook, Glos and he married Mary Helena George in the Tewkesbury area in 1908

**GREENWOOD** John Ledville Pte 27663, Royal Warwickshire regt, died 10/5/1917. Commemorated on the Arras Memorial, France. Formerly Pte 2482 RGHY

**GREENWOOD** William E Pte 2090, Gloucestershire Regt died 19/9/1916. Commemorated on the Angora Memorial 75, North Gate War Cemetery, Baghdad, Iraq

**HERBERT** The Hon, Elidyr John Bernard Capt Royal Gloucestershire Hussars attached to the 19th Machine Gun Corps (Cavalry) died 12/11/1917 age 30. Son of Major General I.J.C., 1st Baron Treown, C.B., C.M.G & Baroness Treown of Llanarth Court, Raglan, Mons. Holder of the Order of the White Eagle (Serbia). Buried in Gaza war Cemetery, Israel, XVIII.B.5

**HILL** Stanley Frederick M.C & Bar, Capt 4th Gloucestershire Regt died 4/11/1918 age 30. Son of William & Hester Ann, 1 Upper Belgrave Road, Clifton. Buried in Landrecies British Cemetery, France A.70

**HUGETT** Wyndham Henry Pte, Acting Cpl 1549 Gloucestershire Yeomanry & Corps of Hussars. 2nd Lt, South Wales Borderers 4th Bn attached to the 10th, died 24.10.1916. Buried in la Gorgue Communal Cemetery, France II.A.14 CWGC & Medal Roll, have him listed as **Huggett and this memorial as Pte**

**HONEY** Alfred or Albert Thomas Sgt 1144 died 21/8/1915. Commemorated on the Special Memorial C 6, Green Hill Cemetery, Turkey

**HUGGETT** Ivor Herbert Sgt 37283 C Coy, 12th Gloucestershire Regt.died 8/5/1917 age 27. Son of Thomas & Mary Elizabeth, Nee Bullock, of The Mervale, Christchurch, Newport, Mon. Commemorated on the Arras Memorial France  
Previously served with R G H

**HARRIS** A J L/Cpl. (CWGC not listed as L/Cpl, possible this person). Alfred James Pte 11472, 10th Gloucestershire Regt died 9/9/1916 age 20. Son of Alfred James & Annie of 101 New Street, Gloster City. Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme. The Medal Roll have him named as Albert J for the same service number

**HART**Reginald Bramley L/Cpl 235252 died 20/10/1918 age 32. Son of James & Edith, of Abbots Leigh, Hucclecote, Glos. Buried in Beirut War Cemetery, Lebanon Republic

**HATCH** William Knowling L/Cpl 2470 died 23/4/1916 age 27. Son of John & Laura, of Terrace House, Ashburton, Devon. Commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial

**HULBERT** Robert James L/Cpl 1798 died 10/10/1915. Son of Thomas W & Annie of Claypitts Farm, Eastington, nr Stonehouse, Glos. Commemorated on the Special Memorial, C.8, Green Hill Cemetery, Turkey

**HAGGETT** Tom Wellington Pte 27666, 16th Royal Warwickshire Regt previously Trooper 3356 Gloucestershire Yeomanry. Died 15/4/1917 age 23. Son of Tom Purchase Haggett of Cargate, 3 Brynwyn, Newport Mon. Buried in La Chaudiere Military Cemetery, Vimy, France. II.A.12

**HANDS** William J Pte 235286 1/6th Gloucestershire Regt, previously Trooper 235473 Gloucestershire Yeomanry, died 9/10/1917. Commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium

**HANDY** Alfred P Trooper 2005 died 5/8/1916. Buried in Kantara War Memorial Cemetery, Egypt D.4

**HARVEY** John Trooper.2426 Gloucestershire Hussars, died 23/4/1916 age 20 son of the late Melville Harvey of Elmbridge Court, Gloster City & Helen, of Glendale House, Montpellier Terrace, Cheltenham. Commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial, Israel  
*On the Medal Roll listed as Acting L/Cpl 2426*

**HAVARD** Walter Trooper. 260514 1st Gloucestershire Regt died 25/2/1919. husband of Mrs F B, of the New Cottages, Longney, Glos. Buried in Cologne Southern Cemetery, Germany IX.B.19
