Lord Apsley, son of Seymour Henry Bathurst CMG.,TD.,JP., DL., 7th Earl Bathurst and of the Countess Bathurst Nee Borthwick of Cirencester Glos. Husband of Lady Apsley CBE, Nee Meeking of Cirencester. Colonel, The Arab Legion MA (Oxon) J.P. Department, Lieutenant for the County of Gloucestershire. Member of Parliament for Southampton 1922-1929 & Bristol 1931-1942. President, United Kingdom Pilots Association. Also served in the First World War 1915-1919. Buried in Malta, (Capuccania) Naval Cemetery Prot Sec (Officers) Plot E Coll Grave 4
