COMLEY Ernest, Sergt 13580 Grenadier Guards died 20/3/1915 age 25. Son of Mr J Comley of Crosshand, Lydney. buried in Bethune Town Cemetery France IV.A.84

GRAIL Clifford George, Capt, 7th North Staffs Regt died 23/7/1915 age 24. Son of George Henry The Old Brewery House, Stratford on Avon BA (Hons) Cantb. Volunteered August 1914. Commemorated on the Helles Memorial Turkey
