**BAKER Algernon R W** Pte 202505, 2/5th Gloucestershire Regt, killed in action on Friday 14/9/1917. Son of William Charles and Sophia, nee Davis of Market Street, Nailsworth. Commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium

**BEALE Charles Ernest** Driver 119097, 18th Reserve, Royal Field Artillery died, 7/2/1916 age 19. Son of Henry and Caroline nee Browning of Forest Green, Nailsworth. Buried in Exeter High Cemetery, Exeter, Devon, grave 27

**BIRD Harold Percy** Pte PLY/2111(S) 1st Royal Marine Light Infantry, Royal Navy Div, died 30/9/1918 age 29. Son of Samuel and Ody Frances nee Fewster of Old Tudor, Stelling, Canterbury. In 1901 they were all residing at The Grange, Dyehouse, Minchinhampton. Buried in Sucrierie British Cemetery, Graincourt-Les-Havrincourt, France A.14

**BOWLEY Joseph William** Pte 17476, 8th Gloucestershire Regt killed in action on Thursday 28/3/1918. son of Thomas and William and Mary J of Harley Wood, Nailsworth. Commemorated on the Arras Memorial, France

**BRAIN Edward Thomas** Pte 1729 Gloucestershire Regt killed in action on Sunday 26/9/1916. Born in Fishponds, Bristol 1891, grandson of Eliza Brain of Malting House, Harley Wood, Nailsworth. Son of Albert Aaron and Lydia nee Ford of 3 Dean Street, Bristol. Commemorated on the Loos Memorial, France

**BRINKWORTH Reginald Arthur** Cpl 41379 2nd Suffolk Regiment Killed in France 23 August 1918 age 22. Son of George Herbert and Clarrisa H Brinkworth of Northfields, Woodchester, Gloucestershire. Buried in Douchy-Les-Ayette British Cemetery, France, II.J.1

**BRINKWORTH William Ernest Charles** Pte 4635 2/5th Gloucestershire Regt killed in action on Sunday 24/12/1916 Son of Ernest Albert & Hattie Eliza nee Harman, Bristol Road Nailsworth Glos. Commemorated at Regina Trench Cemetery Grandcourt Somme I.D.22

**BRISTOW Henry** Pte 15856 6th Dorset Regt, Killed in action in France 5/5/1916 age 22. Son of John and Jemima Ann, nee Gill Windsor Ash, Nailsworth, Gloucestershire and brother of the late William, killed in action 1917. Native of Harefield, Sussex, known as Harry. Buried in Bailleul Communal Cemetery Extension, Nord France II.D.19

**BROWN Albert Edward** Cpl 6600, 16th Rifle Brigade died 2/9/1918. Son of George and Mary Ann of Rooksmoore, Rodborough, Glos, husband of Mrs A Brown of Tudor Cottage, Bath Road, Nailsworth. Previously served as Pte S/17861, 4th Field Coy, Army Service Corps. Buried in St Charles Communal Cemetery, Sedan, France. 439

**BROWN Edwin Charles** CSM RASC [CWGC not listed] *Additional information 1901 Census. Son of Edwin and Margaret Brown, 28 Green Street, Bedminster, Bristol. His occupation was an Assistant Liberian. Born 1876 at Bedminster*

**BROWNE Claude Frank Stankey** Air Mechanic 2nd Class, 53662, 29th Sqdn, Royal Air Force died 30/9/1917 age 30. Husband of Harriet Josephine "Favy" nee Stallard of Corner House, Nailsworth, Glos. Buried in Mendinghem Military Cemetery, Belgium. VI.C.13

**BROWNING Reginald Thomas** Pte 36th Australian Infantry died 7/7/1917 Buried in Messines Ridge British Cemetery, Belgium. V.A.26 In 1901 he was an inmate in Stroud Workhouse with his brother George and sister Lily, no parents shown

**BUCKINGHAM William George** Pte 117999 Machine Gun Corps died 8/4/1918. Son of John and Eliza nee Burrows of Spriggs Well, Amberley, Glos. Buried in Jerusalem War Cemetery, Israel, Q46

**BURFORD Alfred** Pte 235918, Labour Corps 25th February 1919. Age 34. Husband of Eliza Elizabeth H. nee Ball formerly Burford, now Dowdswell of Horsley Rd. Nailsworth. Buried in Shortwood Baptist Chapel Cemetery, Gloucestershire

**CALVERT Eric Ruegg** 2nd Lt Royal Sussex Regt attached to 8th Pioneer Battalion died 8/8/1917 age 27. Son of Thomas Watkins and Maud Harriet nee Ruegg, Capital and Counties Bank, Nailsworth. Buried in Dickebusch New Military cemetery Extension, Belgium. IV.C.1

**CHILD Albert** L/Cpl 11991 Worcestershire Regt died 13/8/1915 age 21. Son of George and Maria E of Downend, Horsley, Glos. Commemorated on the Le Touret Memorial, France

**CLAPPEN Wilfred Joseph** Lt, 10th, Durham Light Infantry died 22/9/1916 age 24. Son of William and Hannah of "Cotswold", Hathaway Road, Southbourne, Bournemouth. B.Sc in Agriculture at Durham University. On enlisting into the army in January 1915 he was Master of Agriculture, North Eastern, County School, Barnard Castle. Buried in Heilly Station Cemetery, Mericourt-LA'bbe

**CLARKE William** Pte 268758, 2/7th Sherwood Foresters Notts and Derby Regt died 10/12/1917 age 27. Son of Frederick and Alice of Nailsworth, husband of Frances of 39 Portland Road, Shirebrook, Mansfield. Buried in Rocquigny-Equancourt Road British Cemetery, Manancourt, France VII.C.3

**CLISSOLD Henry** Major DSO 474th Field Coy, Royal Engineers, died 28/4/1917, age 46. Son of William George and Julia Grosvenor nee Watkins of Chestnut Hill, Nailsworth. Housemaster at Clifton College. Buried in Duhallow A.D.S. Cemetery, Belgium. I.C.49

**COLE George Edward** MM Cpl 17671, 8th Gloucestershire Regt, attached to 17th Light Trench Mortar Bty died on Wednesday 10/4/1918 age 25. Son of Frederick and Maria of Forest Green, Stroud, Glos. Commemorated on the Tyne Cot memorial, Belgium

**COOKE Arthur Edward** Pte CH/1668(S) Royal Marine Light Infantry. Died 28/4/1917 Son of Charles Edward and Eliza, nee Scales of Chapel Road, Ebley, Glos. Commemorated on the Arras Memorial, France.

**CREED Wallace** Pte 204277, D Coy, 6th Somerset Light Infantry died 21/3/1918 age 21. Son of James Ernest and Harriet nee Griffin of Forest Green, Glos. Commemorated on the Pozieres Memorial, France

**EVANS Charles** Pte 21412, 8th Gloucestershire Regt killed in action on Monday 9/3/1917 Commemorated on the Menin Gate Memorial, Ypres, Belgium [*Additional information 1901 Census. Son of Iddo & Louisa Evans nee Chivers of Bunting Hill, Nailsworth*]

**EVANS Orlan Alfred** Pte M2/193674 M.T. Royal Army Service Corps. Died at Devonport Military Hospital 19th February 1920. age 30. Son of Edward and Jemima nee Waite of Inchbrook, near Nailsworth. Buried in Forest Green Congregational Chapel Cemetery, Glos

**GARDNER George** Cpl 8871, 1st Duke of Cornwall's Light Infantry died 27/10/1914 age 25. Son of Job and Ruth of 7, "Egypt", Nailsworth. Buried in Bethune Town Cemetery, France, III.A.2 *This memorial has Private, Worcestershire Regt*

**GUNTER Frank** Pte 19906 13th Gloucestershire Regt, killed in action on Friday 30/6/1916 age 44. Son of Henry Julius and Emma nee Davis of Nailsworth, husband of Ellen nee Stephens, of Watledge, Nailsworth. Buried in St Vaast Post Military Cemetery, Richebourg-L'Avoue, France, III.T.3

**HAINES Henry Francis** Pte 17670 12th Gloucestershire Regt, died of wounds on Sunday 18/3/1917 age 20 Son of W and E of Forest Green, Woodchester, husband of Dora E, nee Pinnell. Buried in Bethune Town Cemetery, France, VI.C.17

**HANKS George Henry** Pte 17385, B Coy, 10th Gloucestershire Regt killed in action 25/9/1915 age 35. Son of George and Hannah of Forest Green, husband of Alice Emily nee Rudge of Downend, near Horsley, Glos. Buried in Cabaret-Rouge British Cemetery, Souchez, France XXVI.M.10

**HARRISON Bertie** Pte 10296, 4th Worcestershire Regt died 6 June 1916 age 29. Son of Daniel Clark and Salome nee Knee of Forest Green, Glos. Buried in Twelve Tree Copse Cemetery, Turkey, Sp Mem C.335

**HEAVEN Joseph Westfell** Pte 7631 1/5th Norfolk Regt died 14/1/1917. Son of Rowland and Sarah Jane nee Parker of Bristol Road, Nailsworth and brother of Robert who also fell. Buried in Shortwood Baptist Chapel Cemetery, Glos

**HEAVEN Robert Wallis** Pte 30758, 1st Devonshire Regt died 4/10/1917 age 19. Son of Rowland and Sarah Jane nee Parker of Bristol Road, Nailsworth and brother of Joseph who also fell. Buried in Hooze Crater Cemetery, Belgium. VIII.E.13

**HINTON James Edward Lewis** MM, CSM 10130, 5th Oxford & Bucks Light Infantry died, 3/5/1917 age 25. Son of James and Elizabeth nee Simmonds of Eynsham, Oxfordshire, husband of Daisy Francis L Smith formerly Hinton of 19 Park Road, Nailsworth. Buried in L'Homme Mont British Cemetery, Ecooust-St, Mein, France I.D.6

**HOBDDAY Charles Leonard** Pte 472608, Canadian Infantry, Saskatchewan Regt died 12/4/1917 age 20. Son of Cyril Leonard and Lilian Hobday, 190 Belizie Road, Kilburn, London. Buried in Villers Stat Cemetery, Villers-Au-Bois, France. VIII.A.4

**HOLBROW Charles** Stoker 1st Class K/23928, HMS Blackprince Royal Navy died 31/5/1916 age 22. Son of George and Ellen of Rowden, Hazel Wood, Nailsworth. And brother of William who also fell. Commemorated on the Portsmouth Naval Memorial, Hampshire

**HOLBROW William Ernest** Pte 10081 2nd Gloucestershire Regt killed in action on Monday 10/5/1915 age 17. Son of George and Ellen nee Scales of Rowden Hazel Wood, Nailsworth and brother of Charles who also fell. Commemorated on the Menin Gate Memorial, Ypres, Belgium [CWGC listed as *Holborow*]

**HOLLOWAY Arthur Reginald** Pte 4419, 1/5th Gloucestershire Regt killed in action, 3/11/1916. Son of George and Emily Jane nee Sharpe of Wormhill Hill, Horsley, Glos. Commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme

**HUMPHRYS George Henry W** Pte 43660, 16<sup>th</sup> Machine Gun Corps (Inf) died 21/3/1918 age 20. Son of William James and Martha Maria Humphrys nee Morse of Shortwood, near Nailsworth. **LARGE Gilbert Raymond** Pte 31110 2nd Kings Shropshire Light Infantry died 5/3/1920 age 22. Son of G E and Ada E, of Rockness Hill, Nailsworth. Buried in All Saints churchyard, Shortwood near Nailsworth . Gloucestershire

**LATHAM William Weaving** Cpl 37144 Duke of Cornwall's Light Infantry died 3/6/1918. Buried in Cologne Southern Cemetery, Germany. VIII.C.8 *Additional Information. 1901 Census. Son of Sarah Lucy Latham nee Cole, widowed 1901, of 3 Victoria Villas, Bath Road, Nailsworth His father was called William*

**LEWIS Frederick** Trooper 235387 Royal Gloucestershire Hussars Yeomanry died 16/8/1916 age 23. son of John and Laura of Forest Green, Woodchester, Glos. Commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial, Israel

**LONG William Herbert Berkeley** 2nd Lt, 216 Siege Bty Royal Garrison Artillery died 31/5/1918 age 19. Son of William Cole and Minna, nee Burrows of Spring Cottage, Watledge, Nailsworth. Buried in Bayneux British Cemetery, Gezaincourt, France. II.C.17

Buried in Hill 10 Cemetery, Turkey I.F.8
