BAKER Algernon Robert William, Pte 202505, 2/5th Gloucestershire Regt. Born 1898 Nailsworth, son of William Charles **Baker** and Sophia (nee **Davis**) of Market Street, Nailsworth. Killed in action on Friday 14/9/1917. Commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial, Belgium. Also remembered on Amberley War Memorial and on The Glosters Cenotaph in Gloucester Park.

BEALE, Ernest Charles, Driver, 119097, 18th Reserve, Royal Field Artillery. Born abt 1897 Nailsworth, son of Henry **Beale** and Caroline (nee **Browning**) of Forest Green, Nailsworth. Died in Exeter Isolation Hospital of meningitis 7/2/1916, age 19, buried in grave 27, Exeter High Cemetery. Also remembered on Woodchester Wayside Cross and on Forest Green Chapel plaque at Christ Church.

BIRD, Harold Percy, Pte, PLY/2111(S), 1st Royal Marine Light Infantry, Royal Navy Division. Born 1889 Nailsworth, son of Samuel **Bird** and Odyphia Frances (nee **Fewster**) of Old Tudor, Stelling, Canterbury. In 1901 they were all residing at The Grange, Dyehouse, Minchinhampton. Killed in action 30/9/1918 aged 29, buried in Sucrerie British Cemetery, Graincourt-les-Havrincourt, France A.14.

BOWLEY, Joseph William, Pte, 17476, 8th Gloucestershire Regt.

Born 1890 Avening parish, son of Thomas William **Bowley** and Mary Jane (nee **Nurdin**) of Harley Wood, Nailsworth. Wife Maud Louisa (nee **Sharp** or **Holloway**), 2 children. Killed in action Thursday 28/3/1918, commemorated on Arras Memorial, France. Also remembered on Woodchester Wayside Cross.

BOWN, Ernest Clough, Co. S-M, T4/248957, Royal Army Service Corps. Born 1892 Stroud, son of John Henry Launchbury **Bown** and Eugenie (nee **Hill**). Died in Nailsworth of pneumonia following influenza 7/3/1919, buried in Stroud Cemetery. N.B. surname wrongly shown as BROWN on metal plaque but correctly as BOWN on stone plaque.

BRAIN, Edward Thomas Smith, Pte, 1729, 1st Gloucestershire Regt. Born 1894 Fishponds, Bristol, son of Thirza **Brain** and grandson of Eliza **Brain** (nee **Fry**) of Malting House, Harley Wood, Nailsworth. Killed in action on Sunday 26/9/1915, commemorated on Loos Memorial, France, memorial ref: Panel 60 to 64.

BRINKWORTH, Reginald Arthur, Cpl, 41379, 2nd Suffolk Regt.

Born 1896 Nailsworth, son of George Henry **Brinkworth** and Clarissa Harriet (nee **Sutton**) of Northfields, Woodchester. Killed in action 23/8/1918 aged 22, buried in Douchy-les-Ayette British Cemetery, France II.J.1 Also remembered on Forest Green Chapel plaque at Christ Church.

BRINKWORTH, William Ernest Charles, Pte, 4635, 2/5th Gloucestershire Regt.

Born 1894 Nailsworth, son of Ernest Albert **Brinkworth** and Hattie Eliza (nee **Harman**) of Bristol Road Nailsworth. Killed in action 24/12/1916, commemorated at Regina Trench Cemetery, Grandcourt Somme, France. I.D.22

Also remembered on Woodchester Wayside Cross and on mother's grave at Shortwood Baptist Graveyard and on The Glosters Cenotaph in Gloucester Park.

BRISTOW, Harry, Pte, 15856, 6th Dorset Regt.

Born abt 1894 Henfield, Sussex, son of John **Bristow** and Jemima Ann (nee **Gill**) of Windsor Ash, Nailsworth, Gloucestershire and brother of the late William who was killed in action 1917. Native of Harefield, Sussex.. Died of wounds 5/5/1916 age 22. Buried in Bailleul Communal Cemetery Extension, Nord France II.D.19. Also remembered on family gravestone at Amberley and Woodchester Wayside Cross.

BROWN, Arthur Edward, L-Cpl, 6600, 16th Rifle Brigade.

Born abt 1880 Avening parish, son of William **Brown** and Jane (nee **Hopes**).

BROWNE Claude Frank Stanley Air Mechanic 2nd Class, 53662, 29th Sqdn, Royal Air Force Born abt 1887 Boxmoor, Herts, son of Charles Montagu **Browne** and Sarah Jane. Husband of Harriet Josephine "Favy" (nee **Stallard**) of Corner House, Nailsworth, Glos. 1 child. Died 30/9/1917 age 30. Buried in Mendinghem Military Cemetery, Belgium. VI.C.13

BROWNING Reginald Thomas Pte 709, 36th Australian Infantry. Born 1894 Stroud son of Charles Thomas **Browning** and Mary Emma (nee **Kemp**).

Left for Australia 18/6/1914, enlisted 20/1/1916.

In 1901 he was an inmate in Stroud Workhouse with his brother George and sister Lily, no parents shown

Died 7/7/1917, buried in Messines Ridge British Cemetery, Belgium. V.A.26 Also remembered on Shortwood Chapel plaque at Christ Church.

BUCKINGHAM William George. Pte 117999 Machine Gun Corps. Born 1889 Amberley, son of John and Eliza (nee **Burrows**) of Spriggs Well, Amberley, Glos. Wife Olive Cassie (nee **Gardner**), 2 children. Died of wounds 8/4/1918, buried in Jerusalem War Cemetery, Israel, Q46. Also remembered on Forest Green Chapel plaque at Christ Church.

BURFORD Alfred Henry. Pte 235918, Labour Corps. Born 1884 Nailsworth, son of William George **Burford** and Sarah (nee **White**). Husband of Eliza Elizabeth H. (nee **Ball**) formerly Burford, now Dowdswell of Horsley Rd. Nailsworth, 7 surviving children. Died Nailsworth 25th February 1919. Age 34, buried in Shortwood Baptist Chapel Cemetery, Gloucestershire

CALVERT Eric Ruegg 2nd Lt Royal Sussex Regt attached to 8th Pioneer Battalion previously 9397, Inns of Court OTC. Born 1890 Nailsworth, son of Thomas Watkins **Calvert** and Maud Harriet (nee **Ruegg**), Capital and Counties Bank, Nailsworth. Killed in action 8/8/1917 age 27, buried in Dickebusch New Military Extension Cemetery, Belgium. IV.C.1 Also remembered on Shortwood Chapel plaque at Christ Church.

CHILD Albert L/Cpl 11991 Worcestershire Regt. Born abt. 1893, Hardwicke, Glos., son of George **Child** and Maria Elizabeth (nee **Forth**) of Downend, Horsley, Glos. Killed in action 13/3/1915 age 21, commemorated on Le Touret Memorial, France. Also remembered on Woodchester Wayside Cross and on Shortwood Chapel plaque at Christ Church.

CLAPPEN Wilfred Joseph 2nd Lt, 10th (Service) Battalion, Durham Light Infantry. Born 1892 Swindon, Wilts, son of William **Clappen** and Hannah (nee **Prior**) of "Cotswold", Hathaway Road, Southbourne, Bournemouth. B.Sc in Agriculture at Durham University. On enlisting into the army in January 1915 he was Master of Agriculture, North Eastern, County School, Barnard Castle.

Died of wounds 22/9/1916 age 24 (listed in De Ruvigny's Roll of Honour), Buried in Heilly Station Cemetery, Mericourt-LA'bbe, France.

Also remembered on Shortwood Chapel plaque at Christ Church.

CLARKE William Pte 268758, 2/7th Sherwood Foresters Notts and Derby Regt. Born 1891 Cirencester, son of Frederick **Clarke** and Alice (nee **Shipton**) of Nailsworth. Wife Frances (nee **Saunders**), of 39 Portland Road, Shirebrook, Mansfield. 2 children. Died of wounds 10/12/1917 age 27, buried in Rocquigny-Equancourt Road Cemetery, France VII.C.3. Also remembered on Shortwood Chapel plaque at Christ Church.

CLISSOLD Henry Major DSO 474th Field Coy, Royal Engineers. Son of William George **Clissold** and Julia Grosvenor (nee **Watkins**) of Chestnut Hill, Nailsworth. Housemaster at Clifton College. Killed in action 28/9/1917,age 46, buried in Duhallow A.D.S. Cemetery, Belgium. I.C.49. Also remembered on Shortwood Chapel plaque at Christ Church.

COLE George Edward MM and Mentioned in Despatches, Cpl 17671, 8th Gloucestershire Regt, attached to 17th Light Trench Mortar Bty. Born 1893 Nailsworth, son of Frederick **Cole** and Maria (nee **Cleaveley** or **Hanks**) of Forest Green, Stroud, Glos. Died on Wednesday 10/4/1918 age 25, commemorated on the Tyne Cot memorial, Belgium. Panel 72 to 75.

COOKE Arthur Edward Pte CH/1668(S) Royal Marine Light Infantry, Royal Navy Division. Missing, presumed killed in action 28/4/1917, commemorated on Arras Memorial, France. **Two conflicting entries have been provided for Arthur Edward Cooke** Son of Charles Edward and Eliza (nee **Scales**) of Chapel Road, Ebley, Glos. Husband of Ellen (nee **Stephens**), of Watledge, Nailsworth. 2 children. Killed in action on Friday 30/6/1916 age 44. Buried in St Vaast Post Military Cemetery, Richebourge-L'Avoue, France, III.T.3. Also remembered on Amberley War Memorial.

HAINES Henry Francis Pte 17670 12th Gloucestershire Regt. Born abt. 1891 Nailsworth, son of William **Haines** and Emily Jane (nee **Wood**) of Forest Green, Woodchester. Wife Dora Eveline (nee **Pinnell**), 1 child. Died of wounds on Sunday 18/3/1917 age 20. Buried in Bethune Town Cemetery, France, VI.C.17. Also remembered on Woodchester Wayside Cross and on Forest Green Chapel plaque at Christ Church.

HANKS George Henry Pte 17385, B Coy, 10th Gloucestershire Regt. Born 1880 Horsley, son of George **Hanks** and Hannah (nee **Cleaveley**) of Forest Green. Wife Alice Emily (nee **Rudge**) of Downend, near Horsley, Glos., 7 children (6 surviving). Killed in action 25/9/1915 age 35, buried in Cabaret-Rouge British Cemetery, Souchez, France XXVI.M.10. Also remembered on Horsley War Memorial and Woodchester Wayside Cross.

HEAVEN Joseph Westell Pte 7631 1/5th Norfolk Regt. Born 1896 Nailsworth, son of Rowland or Robert **Heaven** and Sarah Jane (nee **Westell**) of Bristol Road, Nailsworth, and brother of Robert Wallis who also fell.
