ANDREWS William Frederick, Pte 29525 1st Somerset Light Infantry, died 2/7/1918 age 19. Son of William T & Lucy of Chanenage Lane, Tetbury. Buried in Lapugnoy Military Cemetery, France, X.B.9

APPERLEY Albert James, Pte 235161, Royal Gloucestershire Hussars died 30/12/1917. Commemorated on the Chatby Memorial, Egypt

BAKER James, Pte 9289, 5th Wiltshire Regt, died 10/8/1915. Commemorated on the Helles Memorial, Turkey

BALFOUR John Melville, Military Cross, Major, C Bty, 91st Bde, Royal Field Artillery, died 6/10/1917 age 23. Son of Lt Col Arthur Mackintosh & Florence of 16 Chester Square, London. Buried in Canadian Farm Cemetery, Belgium III.D.7

BALL George Thomas Pte 19718, 2nd Gloucestershire Regt, died 15/12/1918. Buried in Taranto Town Cemetery Extension, Italy I.E.4

BARNES William John, Pte 30908, 14th Gloucestershire Regt died 24/8/1918 age 43. Son of William James & Eliza, husband of Margaret Elizabeth, of The Square, Huntly Glos. Buried in Mountiers Communal Cemetery, France

BARTON Wifrid , Cpl, 1st Royal Gloucestershire Yeomanry. CWGC listed as L/Cpl 1887, Royal Gloucestershire Hussars, died 21/8/1915 age 32. Son of Edward & Jane, “The Knowle” Ampney Crusis, Glos. Buried in the Green Hill Cemetery, Turkey, II.C.3

BATHE Frederick, L/Cpl 5827, 2nd Manchester Regt died 12/12/1914. Buried in Kandahar Farm Cemetery, Belgium. I.B.6

BIGNELL Wilfred, Sgt 8th Gloucestershire Regt. Not listed on CWGC. Found possible - Frederick Sgt 17763, 8th Gloucestershire Regt died 25/10/1916. Buried in the Regina Trench Cemetery, Grandcourt, Somme. VII.M.29

BOND William James, Driver T/364524 Army Service Corps. H.T & S Base, Depot, died 20/12/1918 age 33. husband of Alice nee Smith of Northfield Tetbury. Son of William & Martha of Cheltenham. Buried in Arquata Scrivia Communal Cemetery, Italy. I.A.1

BOULTON Henry Herbert Pte 15903, 6th Royal West Kent Regt died 24/7/1917 age 38. Son of George & Alicia of Tetbury, husband of Alice of 89 East Avenue, Cowley Road, Oxford. Buried in Duisans British Cemetery, Etrun, France. V.A.30

CARTER Joseph Leonard, Pte 1023, 1st Welsh Guards died 16/1/1916 age 23. Son of Alfred and Jane of Twatley Lodge, Malmesbury, Wilts. Native of Doughton, nr Tetbury. Buried in the Royal Irish Rifles Graveyard, Laventie, France. II.B.6

CLEAVER Charles Edward, Pte 28734, 9th Gloucestershire Regt died 10/6/1917 age 33. Son of Joseph & Emily of Tetbury, husband of Florence, of Combers Mead, Tetbury. Buried in Lembet Road Military Cemetery, Salonika, Greece. Grave 1067

CLEAVER Edward, Pte 7788, 1st Gloucestershire Regt, died 29/10/1914 age 27. Son of Frederick & Annie, 10 Harper Street, Tetbury, husband of Bessie. Commemorated on the Menin Gate Memorial, Ypres, Belgium

CLEAVER George Frederick, Pte 10366, 7th Gloucestershire Regt, died 8/8/1915. Commemorated on the Helles Memorial, Turkey

CLIFFORD Robert, Driver 505142 Canadian Engineers Reinforcement Pool, died 20/5/1918 age 41. Son of Maurice Alfred & Harriet of Tetbury, brother of Robert & Charlotte. Husband of Ella of 615 Helmoken Street, Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada. Buried in the Berguetta Churchyard, France, C.8

COLE William Charles Pte 4940, 1st Coldstream Guards died 27/9/1914. Buried in Vailly British Cemetery, France. II.F.9

COMPTON Henry Maurice, Pte 16060 1st Gloucestershire Regt died 9/5/1915 age 18. Son of William & Fanny of Harper Street, Tetbury. Commemorated on the Le Touret Memorial, France

CUSS Albert Sidney Pte 16540, 4th Coldstream Guards, died 10/12/1916 age 20. Son of George & Mary Elizabeth, of Warns Court, Church Street, Tetbury. Buried Guillemont Road Cemetery, Guillemont, Somme I.F.7

DAFFURN William George Pte G/14541 2nd Royal Fusiliers died 23/10/1916 age 19. Son of William P & Emma, of Elmstree, Tetbury. Native of Packington, Warwickshire. Buried in Hamel Military Cemetery, Beaumont, Hamel, Somme I.B.32

DAVIES William James, (*On memorial Sgt 1st Tank Corps*), Possibly - Sgt D/20358 Reserve Cavalry Regt, Company of Dragoons. Previously served in the 6th Dragoon Guards as Sgt, died 12/3/1919 age 37. Husband of M E Davies of 57 Shakespeare Avenue, Milford Haven and son of Oscar & Louisa of Tetbury. Buried in Chiseldon Cemetery Wiltshire, 17A

GARRAWAY Archibald Frederick, Pte 2855, 7th Gloucestershire Regt (CWGC listed as 8th Glostors) died 27/1/1915 age 36. Husband of Mrs A Garraway, 63 West Street, Tetbury, son of William & Harriet of Church Street, Tetbury. Buried in St Saviour churchyard Tetbury

GRIFFIN William Radway, Gunner 98839, 85th Anti-Aircraft Section, Royal Garrison Artillery, died 12/10/1918 age 37. Husband of Mabel Jeanett of Fox Hill, Tetbury. Buried in Ramleh War Cemetery, Israel. Z.68. Son of William & Martha 28 School Lane Cirencester

HANDOLL John L/Cpl 180888, 82nd Field Coy, Royal Engineers died 20/10/1917 age 30. Husband of Mrs L G Handoll of Northfield, Tetbury. Buried at Klein-Vierstraat British cemetery, Belgium III.C.19, (CWGC listed as **HANDELL**)

HARMER Horace William, Electrical Artificer 3rd Class, M/3062, H.M.S. Good Hope, Royal Navy, died 1/11/1914 age 24 Son of Ernest P & Alice M of Tetbury. Commemorated on the Portsmouth Naval Memorial, Hampshire

HAYES Francis George, Seaman, Boy 1st Class J/29317, H.M.S, Clan McNaughton, died 3/2/1915 age 17. Commemorated on the Chatham Naval Memorial, Kent. *Additional information* Born in 1898, in Tetbury

HILL Ernest Edmund, Pte 12762 15th Hampshire Regt. Died 9/6/1917 age 30. Son of Thomas & Emily of Long Street, Tetbury. Brother of Herbert also killed in action.. Buried in Mendingham Military Cemetery, Belgium

HILL Herbert Thomas, Pte 25946, 1st Devonshire Regt died 4/10/1917 age 32. Son of Thomas & Emily of Long Street, Tetbury, brother of Ernest also killed in action. Husband of Grace Irene, 2 Rosedale, Westville, Kingsbridge, Devon. Commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial Belgium.

HODGES Albert Victor, Pte 260123, 1/8 Worcestershire Regt, died 17/8/1917 age 19. Son of Edward & Maria, Harper Street, Tetbury. Buried in the New Irish Farm Cemetery, Belgium. XIII.B.20

HOLBOROW Frederick Bernard, 2nd Lt, 16 Kings Royal Rifle Corps, died 16/4/1918, age 29. Son of Richard & Caroline Fanny of Hillside, Northfield, Tetbury. Commemorated on the Ploegsteert Memorial, Belgium

POOLE Ernest Edward Pte 202039, 4th Gloucestershire Regt. Died 1/4/1917. Son of Henry & Mary, Croft Cottages, Tetbury. Buried in Ste.Emilie Valley Cemeytery, Villers-Faucon, Somme

TEAGLE Albert Percy, Stoker K/4825, H.M.S. Defence. Son of Mrs M A Teagle of Tetbury. Died 31/5/1916 age 27. Commemorated on the Plymouth Naval Memorial, Devon

TELLING Bertram Ernest, Military Medal, L/Cpl 19356, 1st Wiltshire Regt, 10/7/1917 age 21. Son of Alfred & Emma of Oak Cottage, Oak Hill, Tetbury and brother of William also killed in action. Buried in Vlamertinghe New Military Cemetery, Belgium I.F.22

TELLING William Alfred, D.C.M, Sgt 1874, 1st Manchester Regt, died 9/1/1917 son of Alfred & Emma of Oak Cottage, Oak Hill, Tetbury. Buried in Amara War cemetery, Iraq XXIII.A.18

WALKER Walter Pte 9810, 1st Gloucestershire Regt, died 26/9/1915. Son of Titus & Ann of Harper Street, Tetbury. Commemorated on the Loos Memorial, France
