Son of William Townsend and Elizabeth Mary nee Gibson of Bradley House, Wotton-under-Edge and husband of Amy Ellen, nee Phillips of The Bungalow, Gold Hill, Chalfont St Peter, Bucks. Buried in Seaford Cemetery, Sussex

AMOS Helbert Edward Pte 2164 3rd Monmouthshire Regt died 16/5/1915. At rest in Harlebeke New British Cemetery Germany XII.C.1 born in 1872, as Helbert Edward. CWGC listed as Herbert

ANDREWS Lionel Frederick, Able Seaman J/26422 HMS “Contest” Royal Navy. Died 18/9/1917 age 20. Son of Richard & Clara, Dyers Brook House Wotton-under-Edge. Commemorated on the Plymouth Naval Memorial

ANNESLEY William Richard Norton, DSO, Major, Queens Own (Royal West Kent Regt) died 29/11/1914 age 51. Son Gen William Richard, husband of Edith Mackenzie Annesley 16 Greyfriars Garden St Andrews. Served in Egypt Campaign 1886. Buried in St Andrews Western Cemetery Fifeshire E.106

AVENELL John Edward, Cpl 2050 7th The Queen’s (Royal West Surrey Regt) died 21/10/1917 age 40. Son of Thomas & Elizabeth “Fernley” ????? Newark Wotton-under-Edge. Commemorated in New Irish Cemetery Belgium X.D.16
